**Entry fee: \$50 per two-person team plus \$10 for Big Fish (cash only)**

**Tournament runs from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. weigh-in at Sandboy Marina**

**Tournament is live release only, live well or cooler required to preserve Pike caught.**

**Boundaries are waters of Long Point Bay  
(Nanticoke Chute to tip of sand bar at Lighthouse)**

**Cash pay back in prizes: 80 per cent**

**Prizes to top three weights of two fish plus Big Fish**

Teams must leave from Sandboy Marina under a shotgun start. Blastoff at 8:00am sharp

All teams must register and have boats inspected for fish ready to go by 7:45 a.m. on day of tournament

All teams will get a number that must be shown at time of re-entry of the marina so that we now know all teams have returned.

## LPBAA Spring Pike Tournament Rules (2010)

1. Boundaries are waters of Long Point Bay (tip of sand bar at Lighthouse to Ontario Hydro Chute at Nanticoke).
2. No fishing in posted waters (This includes posted marinas and docks).
3. No fishing within 50 yards of a gas pump (station).
4. Participants must wear life jackets when engine is running.
5. Participants must equip their boats with appropriate, approved, operating safety equipment for the size of boat that they are using.
6. You must obey all boating rules.
7. You must get your tag on the morning of the tournament.
8. Every person under age 16 must be with an adult.
9. No live bait or prepared bait is permitted (except pork rind).
10. There is a two fish limit and a minimum size limit of 12 inches.
11. Participants who are late checking in at the weigh-in will be docked a 1 pound per minute penalty. After 10 minutes, you will be disqualified.
12. Participants will be penalized 1 pound for each dead fish at the weigh-in.
13. Decisions of Judges, Tournament Directors and Officials are final and not subject to appeal.
14. Use of radios and cell phones restricted to emergencies only.
15. No alcohol permitted anywhere during Tournament.
