LPBAA Spring Pike Tournament Rules (2015)

- 1. Boundaries are waters of Long Point Bay (tip of sand bar at Lighthouse to Ontario Hydro Chute at Nanticoke).
- 2. No fishing in posted waters (This includes posted marinas and docks).
- 3. No fishing within 50 yards of a gas pumps (station).
- 4. Participants must wear life jackets when engine is running.
- 5. Participants must equip their boats with appropriate, approved, operating safety equipment for the size of boat that they are using.
- 6. Working kill switches are required.
- 7. Working live well required for live release.
- 8. You must obey all boating rules.
- 9. You must get your tag on the morning of the tournament.
- 10. You MUST turn in your tag regardless whether you weigh in or not.
- 11. Every person under age 16 must be with an adult.
- 12. No live bait or prepared bait is permitted (except pork rind).
- 13. There is a two fish limit and a minimum size limit of 12 inches.
- 14. <u>Participants who are late checking in at the weigh-in will be docked a 1 pound per minute penalty.</u> After 10 minutes, you will be disqualified.
- 15. Participants will be penalized 1 pound for each dead fish at the weigh-in.
- 16. <u>Decisions of Judges, Tournament Directors and Officials are final and not subject to appeal.</u>
- 17. Use of radios and cell phones restricted to emergencies only.
- 18. No alcohol permitted anywhere during Tournament.
